Repeated Courses

Repeated course grades are marked by an R and an X. An R (grade) indicates the repeated grade, which is calculated into the semester and cumulative grade point average. An X (grade) indicates the removed grade, which is calculated into the semester grade point average but not in the cumulative grade point average.

Incomplete Grades

When course work in which a student has received a mark of incomplete has been made up, the final grade is entered with I and the letter grade, for example, IA.

Semester Hours

All credit hours are computed in semester hours. All transfer courses taken on the quarter system are converted to semester hours. A semester hour represents one recitation each week for a period of 14 weeks (or its equivalent).

Professional Development

Professional development courses have a credit type of PD. The unit of credit is a CEU and represents 10 contact hours per unit. Professional development units are not considered transferrable academic credits.

Transfer and other External Credit

Transfer credits, other external credits, and prior learning credits are listed before Westminster institutional credit. Transfer and other external credit is not computed in the grade point average. Credit received through prior learning assessment is not considered official until all graduation requirements have been met and may not be transferable to other institutions.

Liberal Education Codes

Courses satisfying general education requirements prior to September 1980 are identified by the abbreviation GE following the course title.

Courses satisfying liberal education requirements beginning September 1980 are identified by the abbreviation LE following the course title.

Academic Calendar

The academic calendar consists of two 15-week semesters (including finals week) in Fall and Spring, a month-long May Term for undergraduate students, and condensed summer semesters for both graduate and undergraduate students. Semesters may include several shorter sessions.

Academic Probation and Suspension

Academic Probation indicates the student has fallen below the minimum grade point average required for good academic standing.

Academic Suspension indicates the student has been suspended from the College for academic reasons.

Competency-Based Programs

Effective Fall 2008

Westminster College uses a project-based delivery methodology in several of its academic programs. Students register and complete projects with assigned credit hours under the semester system. In undergraduate programs, all course work is considered 300-400 level per the college numbering system. In graduate programs, all course work is considered 500-600 level. The grading system is indicated below; grades of "EX" are normally regarded as translating to a 3.5-4.0 GPA, whereas grades of "M" are normally regarded as equivalent to a 3.0-3.5 GPA. Grades of "DN" are regarded as failing work.

Competency-Based Business Programs

Effective Fall 2014

All business-related programs at the undergraduate and graduate program moved to a standard 4.0 grading scale and will report GPA information on the transcript. For grading equivalency and transcript reporting, an "Exceeds" is equivalent to a letter grade of "A" 4.0 GPA and "Mastery" is equivalent to a letter grade of "B" 3.0 GPA.
